After collecting all 19 trading cards, show your answer sheet to library staff at your favorite branch, and receive the Bonus 20 card.


1. Baker Park Library

In 2010, children's book author and illustrator Jerry Pinckney won the Caldecott Medal for this almost wordless version of the fable: *The _____ & the Mouse*.



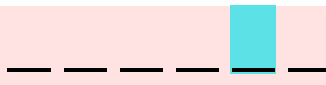
15. Linden Library

The Tale of Two Bad Mice by Beatrix Potter features two mice in what type of house? You can find one at Linden's Library.



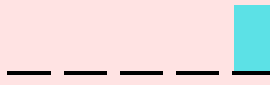
16. Montrose-Jennings Library

What is the name of Harry Potter's Owl?



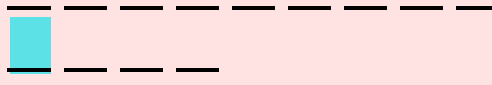
17. Mt. Morris Library
